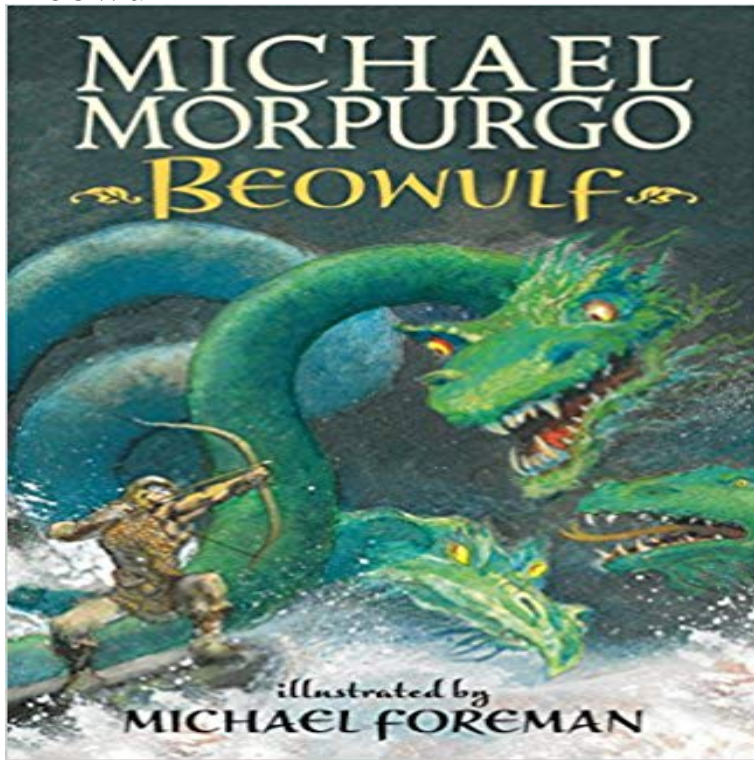


# Beowulf
