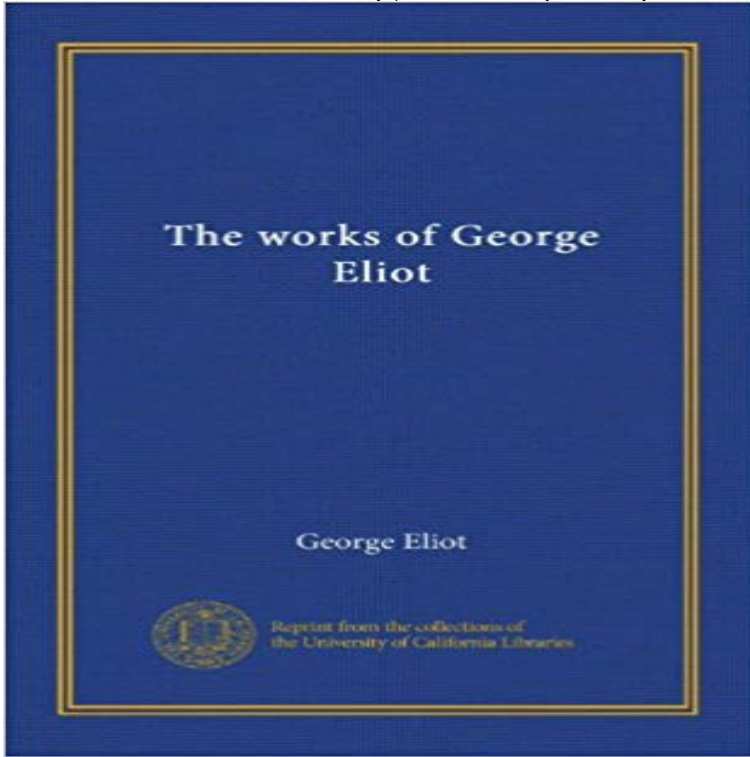


The works of George Eliot (v.16)
