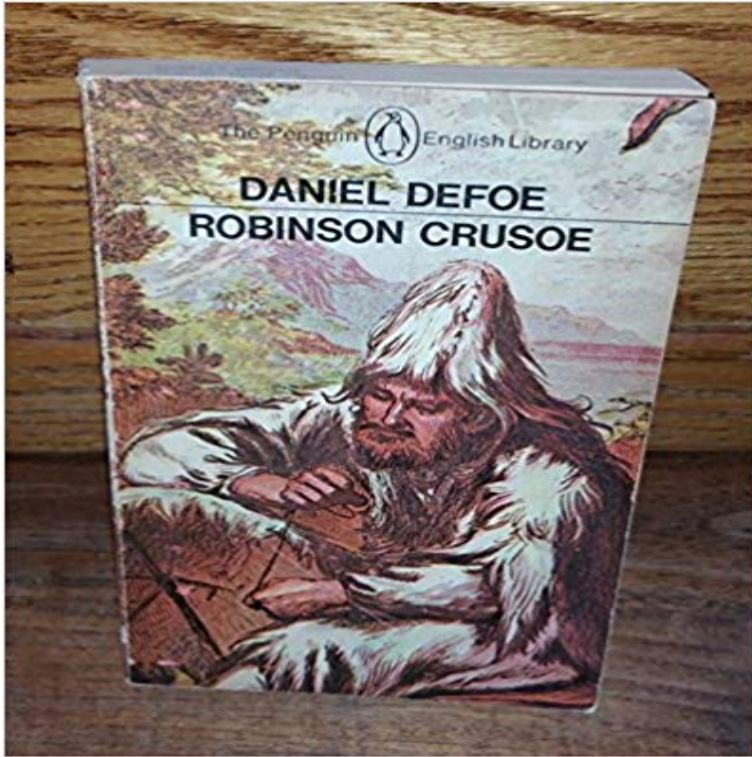


Robinson Crusoe
