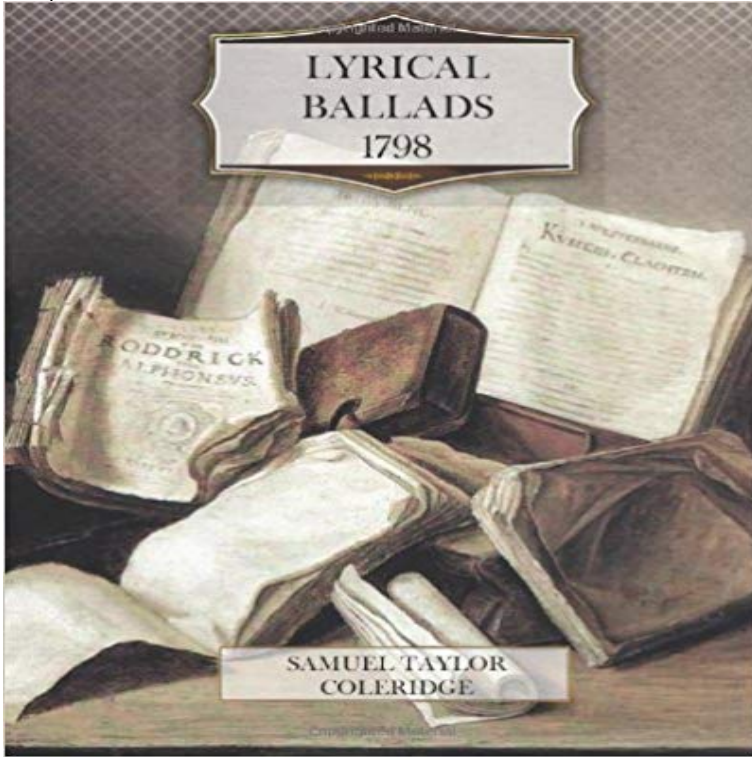


Lyrical Ballads 1798
