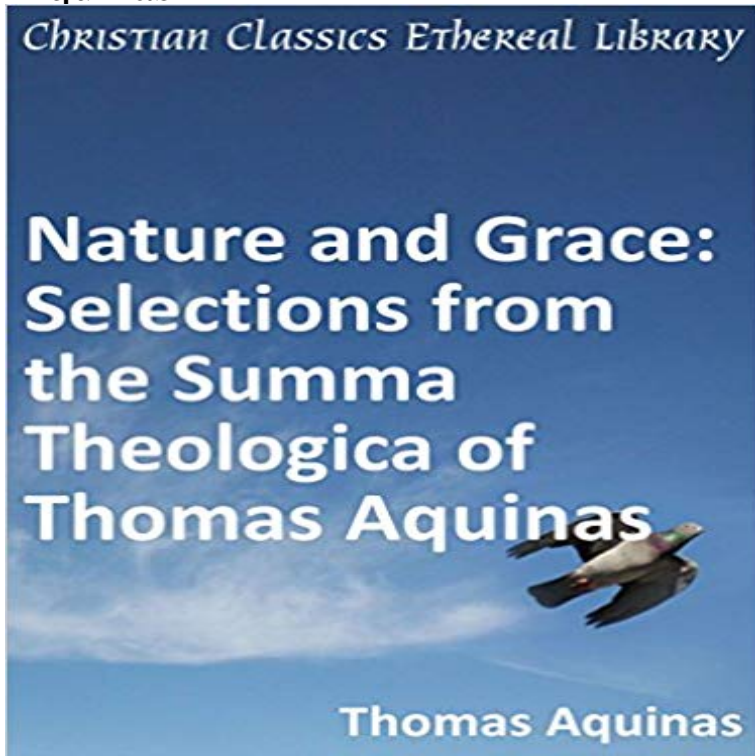


Nature and Grace: Selections from the Summa Theologica of Thomas Aquinas
