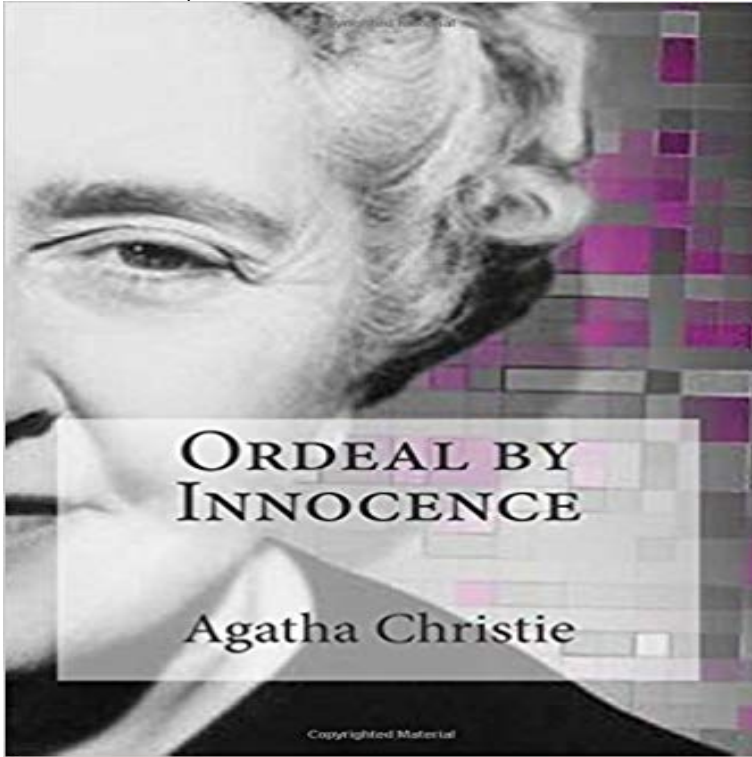


## Ordeal by Innocence
