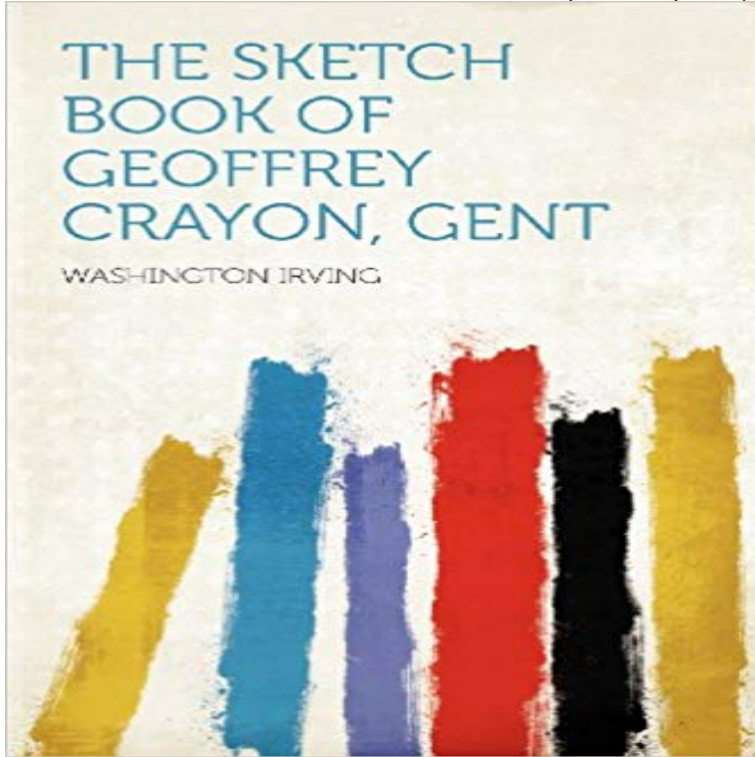


# The Sketch Book of Geoffrey Crayon, Gent
