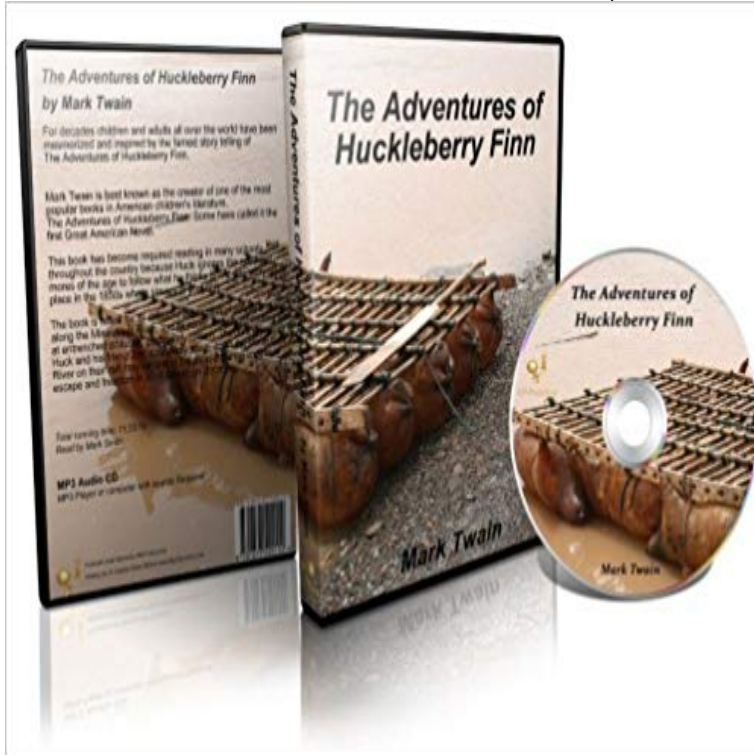


The Adventures of Huckleberry Finn
