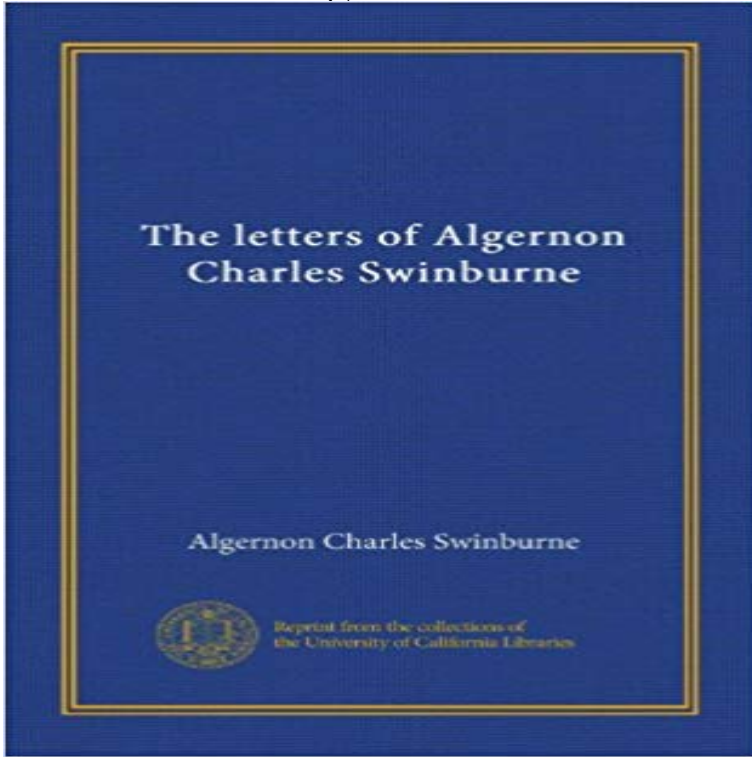


The letters of Algernon Charles Swinburne (v.1)
