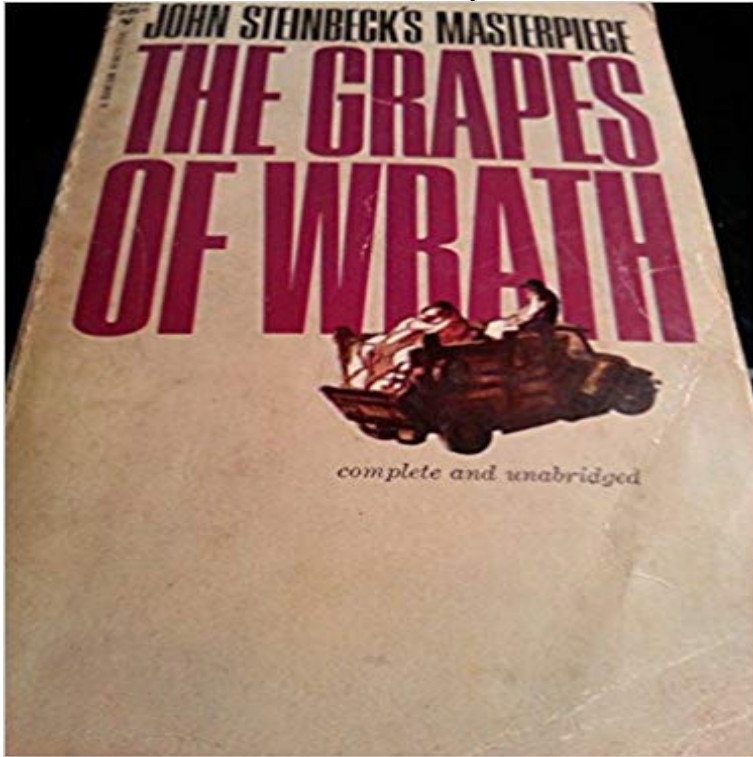


John Steinbeck's Masterpiece: The Grapes of Wrath
