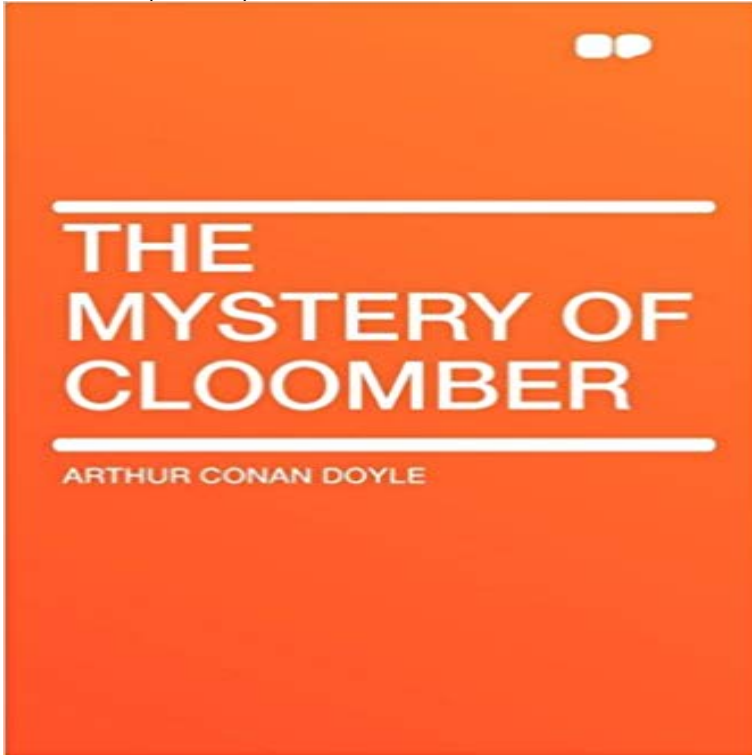


The Mystery of Cloomber
