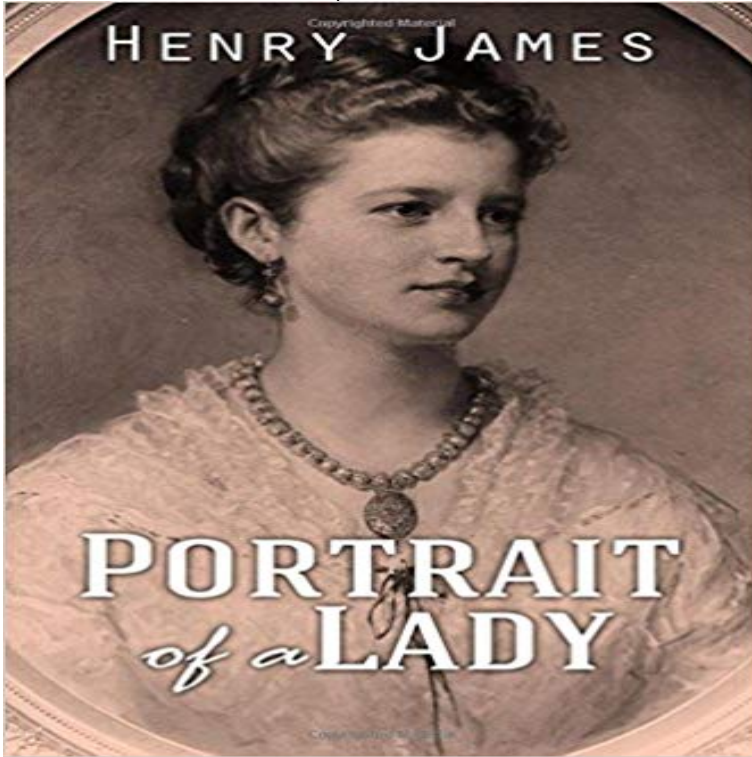


# Portrait of a Lady
