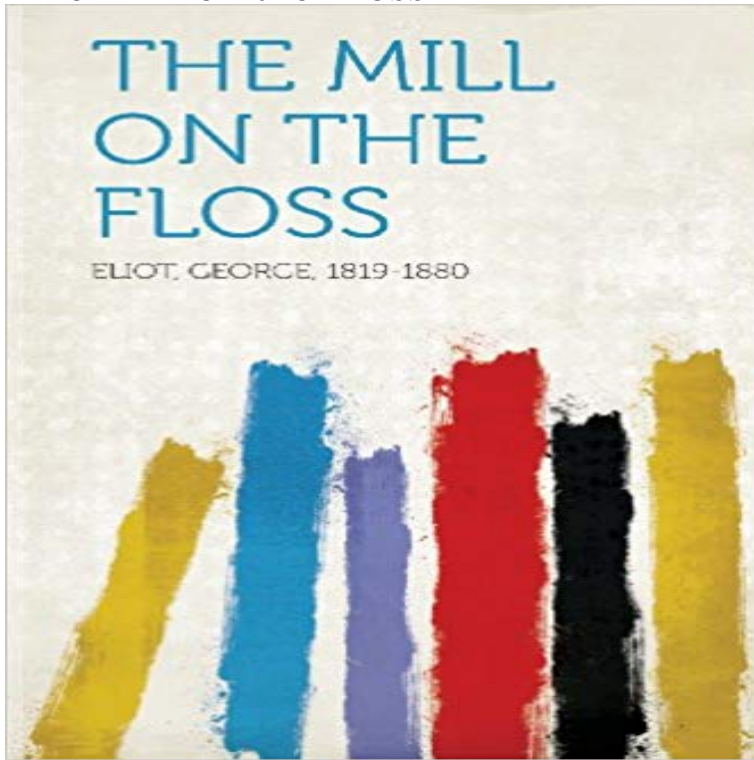


# The Mill on the Floss
