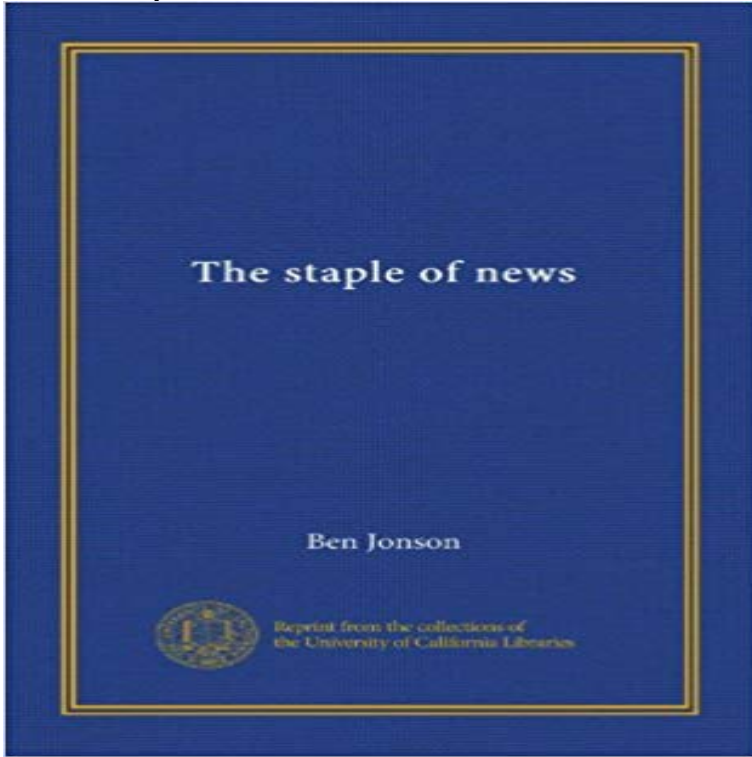


The staple of news
