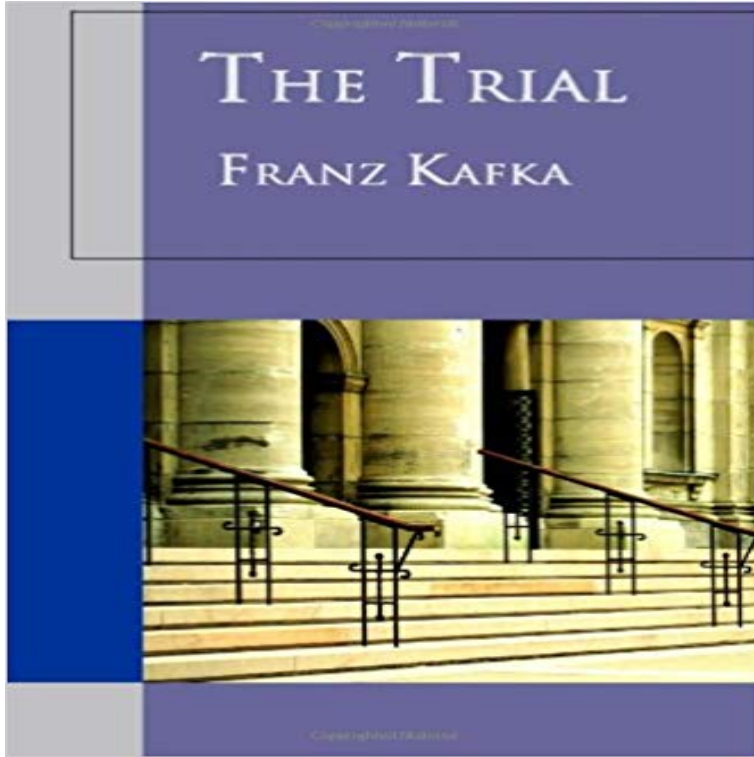


The Trial
