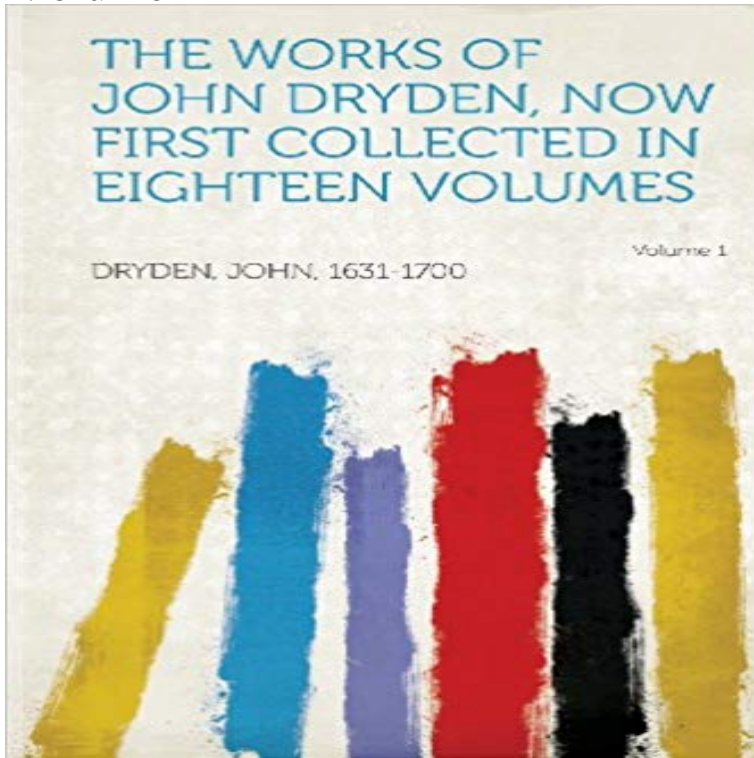


The Works of John Dryden, Now First Collected in Eighteen Volumes Volume 1
