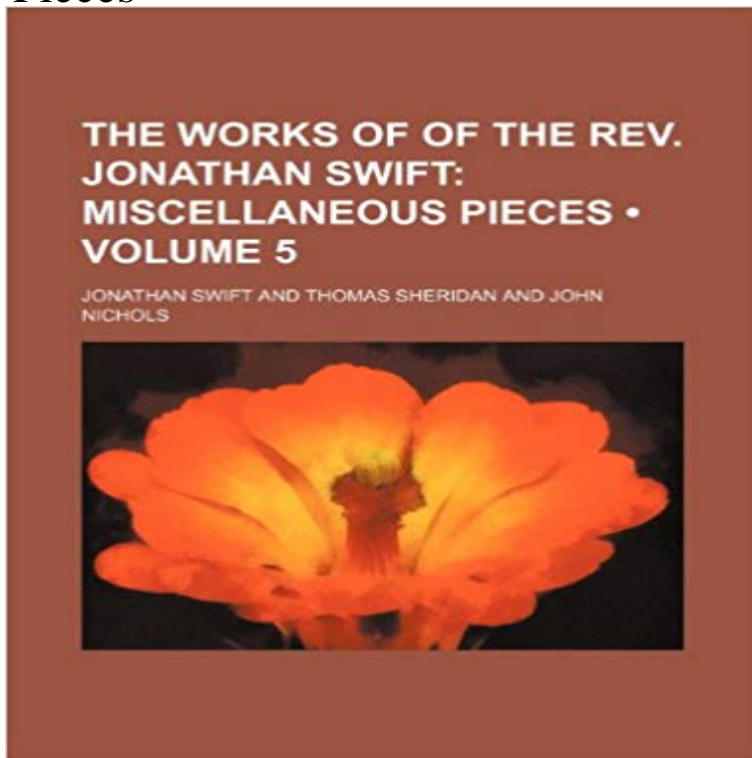

He takes any person of qualitys child from two years old to six, and lets the childs own father or mother take a pike in their hands; then the artist takes the child in his arms, and.tosses it upon the point of the pike, where it sticks to the great satisfaction of all spectators; and is then taken off without so much as a hole in his coat. He mounts upon a scaffold just over the spectators, and from thence throws down a great quantity of large tiles and stones, which fall like so many pillows, without so much as discomposing either perukes or headdresses.
