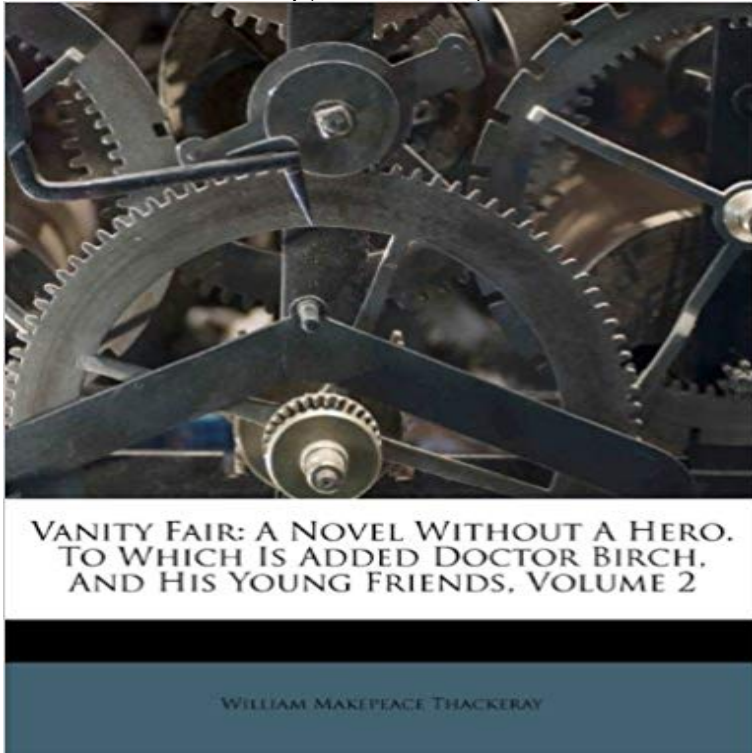


Vanity Fair: A Novel Without A Hero. To Which Is Added Doctor Birch, And His Young Friends, Volume 2
