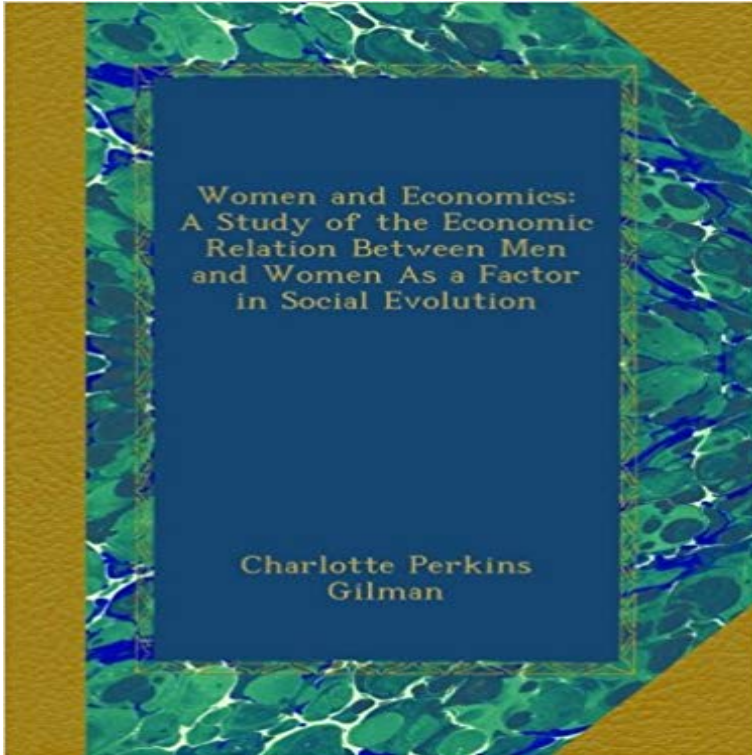


Women and Economics: A Study of the Economic Relation Between Men and Women As a Factor in Social Evolution
